The following questions are offered to help guide you in such reflection.

Do you love God with all your heart, soul, and mind?

Do I have a growing desire to spend more time with God?

Am I spending appropriate time praying, reading, and meditating on the word?

Am I spending time in worship?

Am I growing in my desire to obey and please God?

Do I obey out of gratitude for God's love?

Am I more aware of the sins in my life?

Am I actively serving God in some way?

Am I growing in generosity?

Do you love your neighbor?

Am I loving my family? How, specifically?

Am I forgiving others? Is there anyone among my family, friends, neighbors or coworkers that I refuse to forgive?

Am I growing in my relationships with other believers?

Who have I personally witnessed to in the past year?

How is my neighborhood or workplace different because I am there?

Am I prepared and willing to share my testimony? To share the Gospel?

Am I fervently praying for others?

Am I fervently praying for and planning opportunities to witness in this coming year? What am I doing with my time and money to help the poor and disadvantaged?

If you would like, I would be happy to sit down and discuss anything you learn. I would be happy to help you find resources and methods to help you grow this year.
