# THE PINE NEEDLE - April 2023

I'm not sure it's safe to say, "Spring has sprung" quite yet, but it feels good to at least say "Spring is springing!" If you take a moment and look around, you'll notice the signs of new life that spring brings. Green is replacing brown. Trees are beginning to bud. Flowers are beginning to poke their heads out of the ground. The birds are returning. All around us "dead" things are coming back to life.

But, new life isn't just an outdoor thing. This season of new life in the natural world parallels so well the Easter season on the church calendar. During the 50 days of Easter, we remember Christ's resurrection and we celebrate the new life He brings us. The new life that Christ's resurrection brings is something that happens deep within our souls.

Whether it's taking a walk or sitting on your porch with your cup of coffee, get outside and allow the natural world to "preach" to your spirit. Show up early some Sunday morning and take a cup of coffee into the church courtyard!

I encourage you to set aside some time for personal reflection. Examine your own soul. In the natural world, we see the signs of new life. There should also be signs of new life within us. As the dead places within us come back to life, our lives should be different. We may not bud or bloom like the flowers, but we will bear fruit. We should be able to look at our lives and see where there has been transformation. Are we more loving towards our neighbors? Are we more joyful and thankful than we were last year? Have we become more patient? Just to name a few.

This season may we rejoice in the new life that is found around us and within us! Glory to God! Amen.
