Annual Conference Report

Pine Street was represented by Pat Wittig and Dale Diermyer along with Pastor James at the Susquehanna Annual Conference. A Special Session was held on May 17, 2023, to vote on disaffiliation requests and the regular session was held May 18-20, 2023, at the Community Arts Center in Williamsport. Presiding of the Annual Conference sessions were our resident bishops, Cynthia Moore-Koikoi and Sandra Steiner Ball.

At the Special Session, the Annual Conference approved requests from 141 churches, including 30 churches from the Williamsport District, for disaffiliation from the United Methodist Church.

Some of the actions taken during the regular Annual Conference session of Susquehanna Conference included:

☐ Approval of the Annual Conference budget for 2024. The 2024 budget is \$1,535,544 lower
than the 2023 budget which potentially will keep Shares of Ministry the same as 2023 or
possibly reduce them.
☐ Elected General/Jurisdictional Conference delegates, both clergy and laity, to fill vacancies in
the delegation left by delegates elected for the 2020 General Conference that are no longer
available to serve.
☐ Elected slate of nominations for Conference Boards and Agencies.
☐ Approved clergy benefit plans and equitable salary schedule.
☐ Passed a resolution requesting that General Conference extend the sunset date on
Paragraph 2553 to December 31, 2026.

☐ Did not pass a resolution requesting that a special session of Susquehanna Annual
Conference be held to allow additional opportunity for churches to request disaffiliation
before the December 31, 2023, deadline.
☐ Passed a resolution supporting the Christmas Covenant legislation of 2019.

There were several other resolutions that were before the Annual Conference. The descriptions and the results of the discussions can be found on the website below. Several resolutions in the booklet were withdrawn and so there was no discussion or action on those. The Annual Conference also received reports from Conference Boards and Agencies which are included in the Annual Conference booklet also available on the website below.

Worship is an important part of Annual Conference gatherings. The Celebration of Life and Resurrection was a remembrance of clergy and clergy spouses who have died in the last year. Rev. Charles Moyer was remembered during this service. The Celebration of Ministry service included the ordination of ministerial candidates and the celebration of the service of retiring pastors. Rev Doug Eberly was recognized for his ministry in this service.

Leadership Team Update (6/21/23)

Approved the use of undesignated memorial gifts to fund the phone system replacement and internet infrastructure system. The cost for the phone system is \$2,047 and the cost for the internet system is \$5,908.62. Both replacements will be done by Susquehanna Computer Innovations.

Approved the use of undesignated memorial gifts to fund a Structural and Staffing Workshop with our Unstuck consultant, Mark Meyer. The cost of the 2-day workshop is \$5,000.
