Note from the Pastor

Spring is finally here! Look around and you'll see signs of new life all around us. Trees beginning to bud. Flowers beginning to poke their heads out of the ground. The not-too-distant sound of a woodpecker. All around us "dead" things were coming back to life.

But, new life isn't just an outdoor thing. This season of new life in the natural world parallels so well the Easter season on the church calendar. During the 50 days of Easter, we remember Christ's resurrection and we celebrate the new life that he brings us. The natural world serves as a visible reminder that God is in the habit of bringing dead things back to life. The Rise Up Village Bakery is a relatively new ministry in our community. The bakery provides training in baking skills and offers support and guidance for individuals having difficulty in securing employment. We will be collecting baking supplies for The Rise Up Village Bakery beginning April 14th.

Family Promise has invited us to try a new thing. One of the things that Family Promise lost as a result of COVID-19 was the interaction between church members and the residents. Now that Family Promise residents stay at the day center rather than staying in area churches, it's far easier for us to simply drop of meals and leave. So, at some point during our week to host (April 21-27), we're going to host a potluck at the Family Promise building. This will give us a chance to connect with the residents and each other.

It's a little further out, but on May 30- June 1, the Susquehanna Annual Conference of the

United Methodist Church will once again meet in Williamsport. There will be over 1,000 people meeting at the CAC (just a block away) and they will be hungry! On Thursday, May 30th and Friday May 31st, we will be making bagged lunches to help feed the conference-goers. We can use your help! Stay tuned for more details.

I look forward to what new things God will do in our lives and in our church this spring!
